

Monmouth County Living

Red Bank is in the heart of Monmouth County's Two Rivers area—a peninsula south of the Navesink River and north of the Shrewsbury River that extends east to the Atlantic Ocean. It has a thriving downtown and is surrounded by lovely suburbs—Fair Haven, Rumson, Little Silver, Shrewsbury and Middletown. The picturesque horse farms of historic Freehold and Colts Neck lie less than 30 minutes to the west ; the historic Ocean Grove Camp Meeting Association community with its splendid Great Auditorium is 20 minutes to the south. The region has great weather-- a noticeable change of seasons, but temperatures sufficiently moderate to allow outdoor activity much of the time.

Towns in the Red Bank area offer excellent schools including a full range of public schools, plus charter schools, independent schools and specialty high schools. Institutions of higher learning are Brookdale College, the County College of Monmouth, in the Lincroft area of Middletown, and Monmouth University, a private university, in West Long Branch.

In addition to its beautiful beaches and great boating, Monmouth County is known for superb parks. The 30 parks in the Monmouth County Park System offer a full range of activities for people of all ages. The county is also home to Sandy Hook, the New Jersey section of Gateway National Park, which surrounds New York Harbor. And speaking of New York, it's just a little over an hour to the Big Apple and all it has to offer. Trains, buses and boats depart frequently to Manhattan. Other popular destinations include historic Philadelphia, Bucks County and Lancaster County, Pennsylvania.
